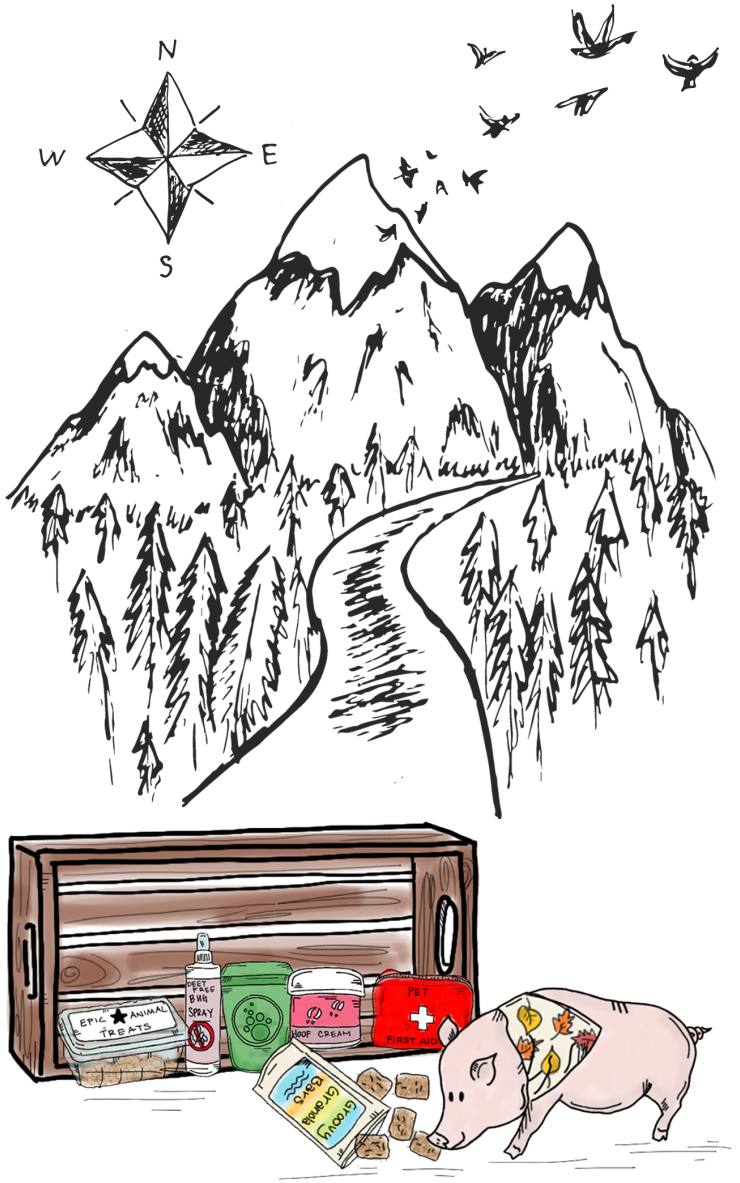

DID YOU KNOW?



Hooves can crack, bruise and rot. Keep your piggie's feet in great condition by doing routine nail trimmings, keep oiled and or moisturized. As your piggie explores outside, watch changes in their stride (gate) limping or other abnormal signs. Check hooves regularly for stickers, or thorns, discoloration and lesions.



Beware of acorn poisoning! Young oak leaves or green acorns are the major sources. Signs of poisoning are seen two to three days after ingestion. These include abdominal pain and constipation followed by hemorrhagic diarrhea. The kidneys may also be affected, producing dark colored urine.



It's important to know the kind of snakes + spiders that live in your area and how they will behave when you come upon them. If your pig is bitten by a snake, it is best to assume it is a venomous bite. Venomousness spider bites typically have a red or blueish swollen area around the bite mark. Clean the wound. Use mild soap and water and apply an antibiotic ointment. Apply a cool compress to reduce swelling.
